 Decision to develop a new Plan of Action for Social Forestry 2021-2025 made at the 13th AWG-SF Annual Meeting in Brunei in June 2019.

- Workshop on the Development of the Plan of Action for ASEAN Cooperation in Social Forestry (2021- 2025) organized in Indonesia in February 2020.

Highlights of the PoA for ASEAN Cooperation on SF 2021-2025

STRATEGIC THRUST 1: Enhancing SFM

 Deployment of advanced IT tools for monitoring changes in social forestry (apps, databases, remote sensing, drones)

STRATEGIC THRUST 2: Enhancing Trade Facilitation, Economic Integration and Market Access

 Responsible investment, non-timber forest product standards, social forestry product certification

STRATEGIC THRUST 3: Enhancing the Forestry Sector Resilience and Role in CC

STRATEGIC THRUST 4: Institutional Strenthening and Huan Resources Development

- 2. AWG-SF to provide knowledge on the role of SF to CC negotiators

- Submit to the 23rd Meeting of the ASEAN Senior Officials on Forestry in Thailand in July 2020
- Final endorsement by the 42nd Meeting of the ASEAN Ministers on Agriculture and Forestry in Cambodia in September 2020.
